

# 2010-2011 CALENDAR TEMPLATES (one month per page) for High School Planners

Include a schedule of all your school's activities in one place. Calendar pages are considered part of handbook pages and can only be ordered with Custom Planners (HSC). Be sure to include them in your total handbook page count. **Note:** 1 page is 1 side of a sheet of paper.

For **Kindergarten, Primary, Elementary, and Middle School Planner** Calendar Templates, go to the *Download Center* of our web site. Use the template indicated for KGC, PRC, ELC, and MSC.

High school calendar pages will be printed in black ink on white paper and placed in the front of your planners (after the cover sheet or other handbook pages). Calendars will be turned sideways to maximize the page size, displaying one month per page as shown on the following pages.

## Instructions:

- This PDF allows you to type directly into the box for each date. Simply click on any date, and a cursor will appear. Type events in the proper dates and save your file. When you are finished, send this PDF with your order. **For Mac users:** Mac OS X has a built-in PDF reader that will show the form fields; however, it will display incorrectly and cannot be saved. Please open the PDF in Acrobat Reader.
- If you prefer a different layout, you may create your own calendar design. Follow the guidelines for handbook pages on p.21 of our *2010–2011 Student Planner Catalog* or go to our web site for instructions. Please send pages in black ink on white paper. **Do NOT fax** pages. You may also convert pages to a PDF using our web site. Click on the “Submit Material” link for instructions.
